About the College:

College Establishment and Development:

The first period (1413 - 1418 AH): In recognition of the role of women in society and in the interest of the sound scientific upbringing of future pioneers and the development of their role in this region, and in a natural response to the need for primary education schools for academically and educationally qualified female teachers, this college was established in the year 1413, affiliated with the General Presidency for Girls' Education In its beginning, it was an intermediate college for preparing female teachers with two-years-study and grants the graduates an intermediate diploma college until 1418H.

Subsequent Period: (1418-1430): With the continuous push for development in the Kingdom in all areas

Fields, especially education. The number of years of study at the Intermediate College was raised to four years, and thus the name was changed from the Intermediate College to the Girls' College in the academic year 1418/1419 AH.



In the year 1423/1424 AH, affiliation was approved in the four literary departments of the college: (Islamic Studies - History and Civilization - Arabic Language - English Language), and in 1427 AH the affiliation was canceled Department of English. In the year 1428 AH, the college administration and its subordination were transferred to Riyadh University for Girls, which was later renamed Princess Noura bint Abdul Rahman University.

The current period (1430 - until now): In the year 1430 AH, the administration of the college and its affiliation was transferred to King Saud University, then the administration of the college and its affiliation was transferred to the University of Al-Kharj in the year 1431 AH, and in line with the requirements of the quality of education, the college was restructured by a decision of the Higher Education Council No. (3/1430) and the date of 4/7/1430 AH,

In the academic year 1431/1432 AH, the College of Education became including the Boys and Girls Departments.

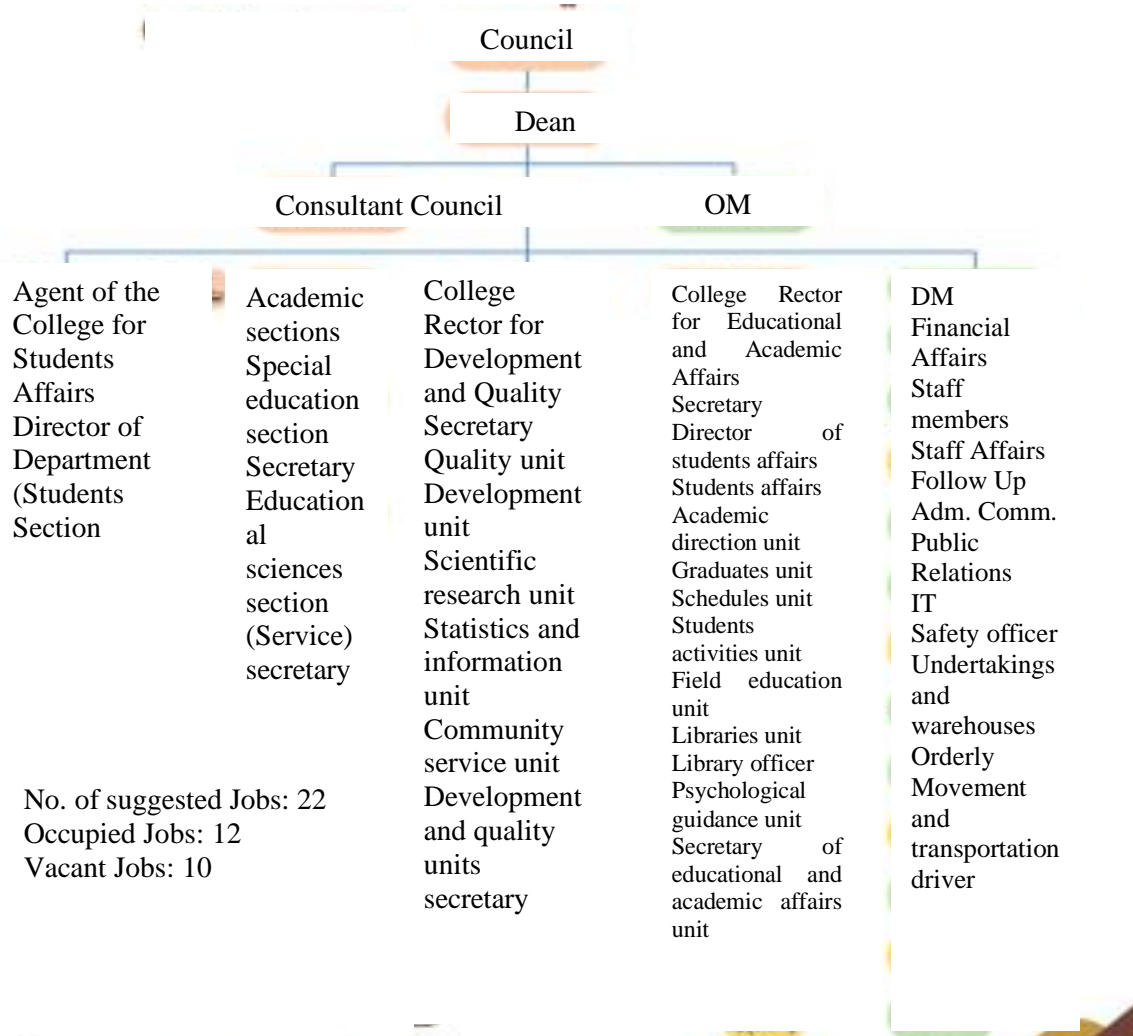

Role of the College in Facing Covid – 19 Pandemic

Based on the resolution issued by the Ministerial Resolution No. 110026, dated on 26/12/1442H, to continue online learning in higher educational establishments, the College has applied a number of precautionary measures to face the Pandemic including:



- Forming a team to manage the Corona crisis and follow up on developments headed by His Excellency the Dean of the College.
- The college administration's keenness to communicate with the university's specialists to follow up on developments in that aspect.
- Paying attention and focusing on the educational goals in particular from the strategic plan and not disrupting the teaching line of the courses.
- Organizing a series of events and workshops for faculty members to train on using the Blackboard effectively
- Activating the public room (virtual session), discussions, creating tests, and dealing with the assessment center.
- Organizing a series of events and workshops for students to train them to use the Blackboard effectively.
- Emphasizing the members and the student to attend the university's activities in relation to training and to use the blackboard effectively.



- Providing direct and continuous technical support to faculty members and students in accessing the system and the Blackboard.
- Providing a set of instructions about electronic exams and encouraging members to conduct experimental electronic exams for students, and following up on that.
- Follow-up on the implementation of health protocols.
- Urging the college's employees to download the "Tawakkulna" and "Space" applications.
- Urging college employees to adhere to the precautionary measures and take the vaccine to prevent corona.
- The matter that led, by the grace of God, to reach the final exams safely, taking into account that there was no defect in the study plans for teaching courses.



The college's role in combating drug addiction and raising awareness about it:

- The college's participation with the joint committee with the General Directorate of Narcotics Control in all awareness, training and anti-smoking aspects at the university.
- The participation of faculty members in the joint work committee with the General Directorate for Drug Control in the awareness, training and anti-smoking aspects of the university, through the establishment of several events.
